

UCMAS, MENTAL ARITHMETIC at Elian's British School, La Nucía

UCMAS lessons started two years ago at Elian's La Nucía and we already have classes of three different which are all very successful.



UCMAS is an abacus based course that teaches children to complete mental calculations by using patterns. The three levels on offer at Elian's La Nucía are Intermediate B, Kindergarten 3 and Kindergarten 1. The Intermediate B pupils have been doing UCMAS for two years and we have students between 10 and 13 years old. Kindergarten 3 pupils have between 5 and 6 years of age and Kindergarten 1 students start when they are only 4!

The UCMAS teachers are delighted with the progress of the students and both pupils and parents are very happy with the improvement on various academic aspects that the study of UCMAS gives them.

Last year one of our Intermediate B students represented our school in the 1<sup>st</sup> National UCMAS Competition. We hope to be represented again in the next one by many of our students.
